

No Fall Clean-up for This Garden



Through the winter this garden will continue to provide a **refuge** for butterflies, bees, fireflies, ladybugs, and other beneficial insects that overwinter. **Birds** will benefit from the seeds and cover left from plants allowed to stand through the winter. The leaves and stems will provide **habitat** in the spring and **enrich** the soil.

Allowing the plant material to remain in the garden promotes **carbon sequestration**. (More info: westcook.wildones.org)
